In the art area, the children painted pictures of our school and the different people who work here.



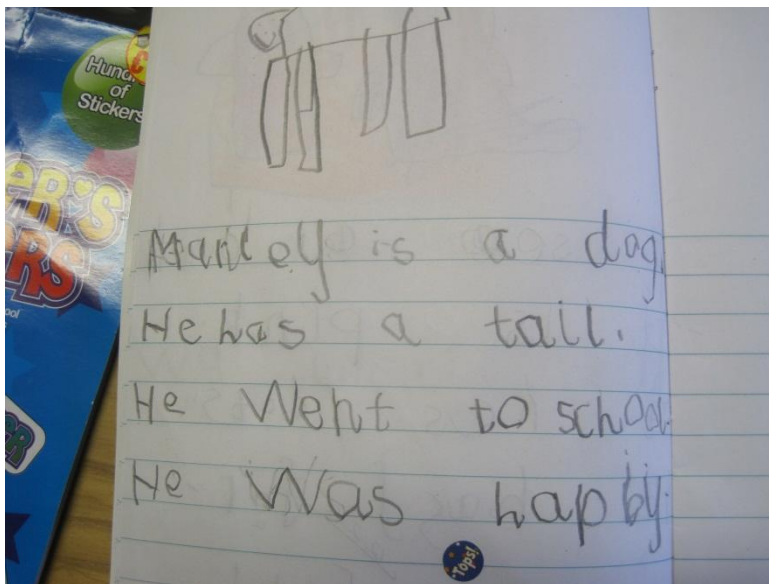


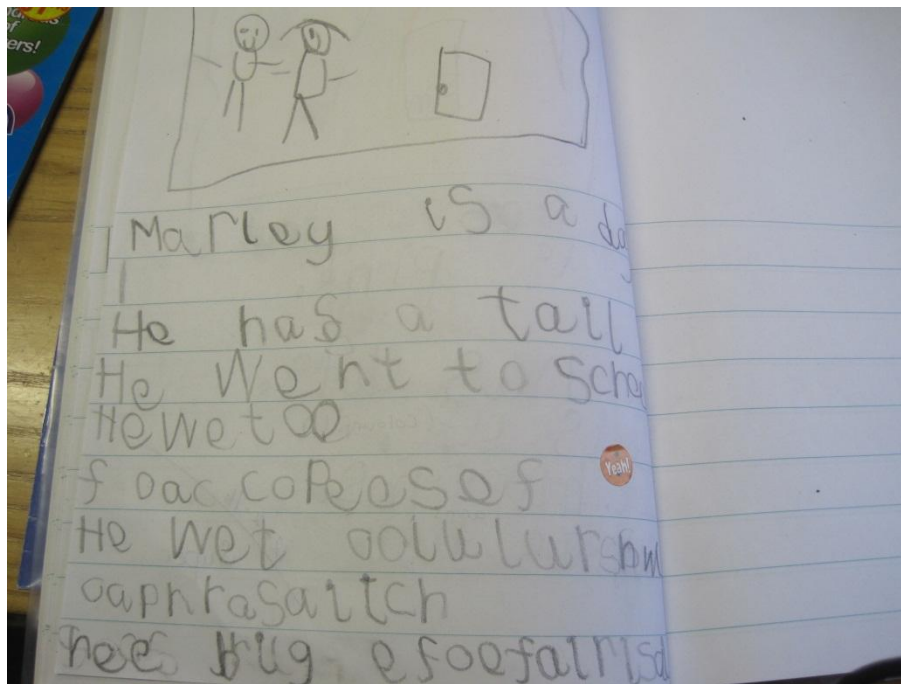

In the crazy art area, the children constructed the staff of the school.





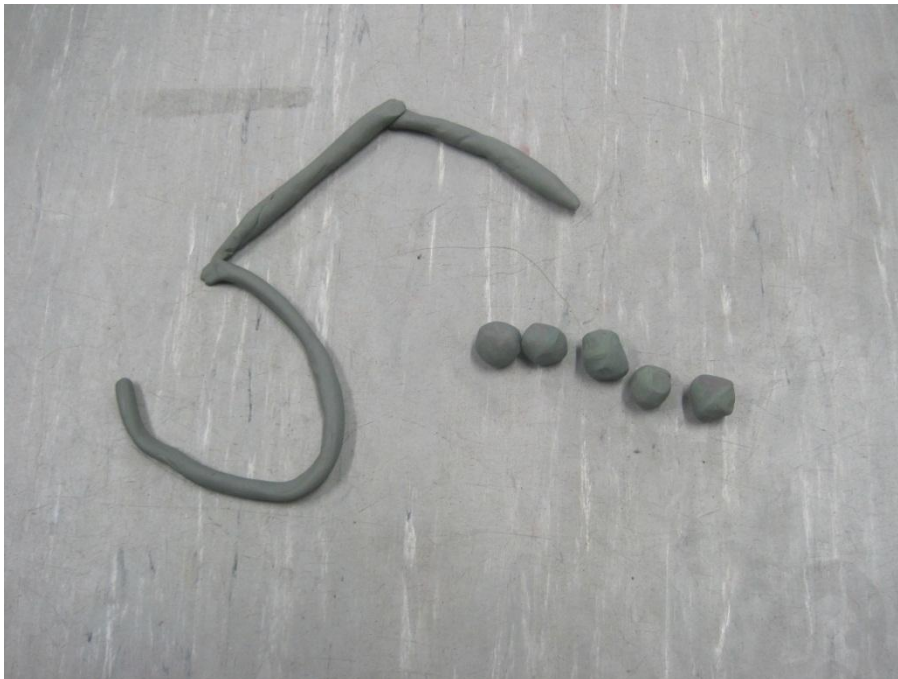
Everyone is doing a great job with their handwriting.
